Endowment EIN Change Request

An Employer Identification Number (EIN) is also known as a federal tax identification number, and is used to identify a business entity. MidwayUSA Foundation uses the EIN associated with an endowment for two purposes:

- 1. To determine who may receive cash grants from the endowment. Only the EIN organization linked to the endowment may apply for and receive cash grants from the endowment.
- 2. For government reporting of issued cash and non-cash grants (Forms 1099-MISC and 990 Schedule I)

The EIN does not indicate ownership of the endowment account. MidwayUSA Foundation is a public charity, not a bank. An organization associated with an endowment does not own, control, or have a right to the endowment or the funds (donations and earnings) in the endowment. All endowments and funds therein are the property of the MidwayUSA Foundation and are under the control of the Foundation's Board of Directors. Therefore, an organization's endowment balance is simply the measure by which the MidwayUSA Foundation determines how much of a cash grant the organization may receive.

A governing official is a Board Officer, School Administrator, or someone in a Leadership position within the EIN entity.
