




Federal Aid in Wildlife Restoration excise taxes are generated by hunting-related and non-hunting-related activities.

% of 2020 Taxable Sales Intended for Non-Hunting














## What ages were the shooting sports participants?\*



## Where do shooting sports participants live?





## YOUTH SHOOTING SPORTS IMPACT ON **CONSERVATION AND R3 EFFORTS\***

- There are more than 4.5M youth target shooters in the US, aged 6-18 years old
- Collectively they spend over \$1.8B per year on firearms, ammo, and accessories
- 74.2% of Wildlife Restoration funding comes from non-hunting sources.
- Target shooting (and personal defense) generates more federal aid dollars for the benefit of conservation and hunting than all hunting-related sales combined
- Our youth target shooters are the key to preserving and growing our industry and our Nation's conservation programs.

"We take pride in promoting safety awareness around firearms. By demonstrating a sense of responsibility and ethical behavior in shooting sports, it ultimately leads into an interest in, and an appreciation for, small and big game hunting."

On average, our cash grant support 60,000 of youth shooters and 4,000 coach volunteers each year.

"The goal of the Ida Trap Shooting Team is for every shooter to participate for free. Besides a \$125 signup fee that pays for the shooters jersey, sweatshirt, hat and membership fees; every other cost is covered by the team. This includes all ammunition for events and practices, entry fees, range fees and targets."


