Eligibility

MidwayUSA Foundation AirGun Fundraiser Camp – This event is open to athletes of all ages and skill levels, although we encourage participants to take a basic firearms safety and handling course before attending.

MidwayUSA Foundation AirGun Match – All camp participants are welcome. Additionally, the match is open to any competitor wishing to add an international-style AirGun Match to their schedule. A limit on available firing points may apply; however, if registration exceeds the capacity for a single relay, a second relay may be added.

Registration and Fees

Registration for these events is a **donation to a MidwayUSA Foundation endowment-holding team or organization of your choice**. 100% of your registration will be directed to that endowment as a donation, and the MidwayUSA Foundation will match according to the current matching policies found here:

Registration for both the camp and match will be handled through CMP's Competition Tracker.

- Camp Registration - Pre-event registration is required and will close two weeks prior to the event, or when the camp is full. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Match Registration – Pre-event registration is NOT required but is recommended to ensure firing points are available. If pre-registration does not indicate a second relay is necessary, capacity will be limited to 75 athletes and late registrations above that will not be accepted.

Fees:

- Match Only: \$50
- Athlete Camp Registration: \$400
- Coach Camp Registration: \$175

Coach Registration

Coach registration is for adults attending with athletes who want to stay on the range during camp training. Registered coaches can interact with the Elite Training Coaches during training and classroom discussions and will be provided with lunches alongside the athletes. Adults not registered as coaches or athletes will not be permitted to stay on the range during this training camp.

Coach registration is not needed for the Saturday match.

Check-In

Camp Check-in – Staff will be present to check participants starting at 12:00pm (noon) on November 19th at the front desk of the Gary Anderson Competition Center at Camp Perry.

Match Check-in – Staff will be present to check any match-only participants in starting at 8:00am on Saturday, Nov 22, at the front desk.

Equipment

For those attending the camp and needing equipment, there will be a small amount of equipment available for use during the camp and match.

During the match, all shooting equipment should comply with current CMP and ISSF Rules. There will be no equipment control for the match, and no post-competition checks will be conducted, but athletes are still expected to abide by the rules and any equipment that visibly appears non-compliant may be subjected to scrutiny.

Rules

CMP Rules, ISSF Rules, and Match Director Bulletins will govern this match. All competitors are responsible for their compliance with these rules. However, no specific checks will be conducted prior to the match.

Course of Fire

The match will consist of a single 60-shot match according to CMP and ISSF formats for qualification in air rifle and pistol, with the exception that all men and women will shoot as Co-ed competitors. An Open Final will be held at the conclusion of qualification for each event; however, no Junior Finals will be held.

An open practice will be held on Friday, Nov 21, from 2pm-5pm and is open to all competitors.

Start Lists

Start lists for the match will be released to all competitors and listed on the CMP CT website for the match (please see the event link at the top of this document). It is the competitor's responsibility to check the Start Lists for their designated match time and firing point. We will have the start list available shortly after registration has closed.

Award Categories

For both Rifle and Pistol events, awards will be presented to the top three competitors in each category:

- Open Winner: Decided by the winner of the Final
- Junior Winner: Decided by qualification scores *

*Junior competitors having been awarded an Open Award will not be eligible for Junior awards

Finals

Finals will be held in accordance with the CMP and ISSF Rulebooks for 2024-2025. All athletes are eligible to qualify for the finals.

Side Games

There will be a variety of side games and sweepstakes available during both the camp and the match.

Protests

Protests will be accommodated according to the CMP Rulebook.

Officiating

CMP and MidwayUSA Foundation staff will constitute the Range officers, and Match Director, and will resolve any protests and challenges. Match Director decisions will be final.
